Scott Hultman, MD, MBA, FACS, is currently Professor and Vice Chair of Plastic Surgery at Johns Hopkins University, where he is also Medical Director of the Johns Hopkins Bayview Burn Center and Fellowship Director for Surgical Critical Care. Nationally, in the United States, he currently serves as President of the Plastic Surgery Foundation, on the Executive Board of the American Society of Plastic Surgeons, on the Plastic Surgery Review Committee for the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education, and as Associate Editor for the Annals of Plastic Surgery. He is a past President of the American Council of Academic Plastic Surgeons. After obtaining an undergraduate degree in psychology at Brown University, he received his medical degree from the University of Pittsburgh. Dr. Hultman then completed his surgical training at the University of North Carolina and Emory University and remains triple-boarded in Plastic Surgery, General Surgery, and Surgical Critical Care. The author of over 200 scientific articles, editorials, chapters, and books, Dr. Hultman has mentored over 50 surgeons who are now chiefs, directors, or clinicians in academic plastic surgery. His clinical interests include burn reconstruction, critical care of the burn patient, hand surgery, and aesthetic surgery.
